

Welcome to Buck Mountain!

Riding on Buck Mountain roads and trails is a PRIVILEGE, not a right.

Your **ATV MUST BE REGISTERED BY A PROPERTY OWNER**, or you may not ride it on the roads or trails.

You must obey **ALL** rules established by the association – some of the important guidelines are highlighted below for your convenience:

- Quiet Hours are from 10 PM to 8 AM each night. Ride only on roads (no trails) and limit your speed to 15 MPH.
- <u>Slow down</u> when approaching pedestrians or other vehicles. Excessive speed is the quickest way to lose the privilege of operating an ATV on Buck Mountain.
- <u>Stay on marked trails</u> as many of them are recreational easements through private property. Wandering off the marked trails may subject you to trespassing charges.
- Ride single file when riding in a group on our roads, and maintain the vehicle in the right-hand lane at all times. Failure to follow this simple rule can cause serious injury or loss of life.
- No doughnuts or horse play is permitted at any time respect your surroundings and our members. Our roads and trails are not a sporting track, and we expect everyone to ride respectfully.
- No dirt bikes, two-cycle sport ATVs, or excessively loud engines this is a residential community, not a sports training center.

Failure to follow guidelines established by the association is punishable by fines of up to \$100 per day
