

## OFF-ROAD VEHICLE REGISTRATION FORM

(A completed form is required for each vehicle)

### Regulations and Responsibilities

1. The operation of off-road vehicles on POA right-of-ways and common areas is a privilege, not a right. As such, operation of this vehicle in an unsafe or inappropriate manner, or in contradiction with any published POA rule or restriction, may subject the vehicle, operator and/or riders from suspension of such privilege.
2. The vehicle will display an identification tag on the vehicle at all times according to rules as established from time to time by the POA. It is understood that the vehicle is subject to being stopped by security patrols, Directors, the Safety Coordinator or other property owners to ensure proper identification or to advise the operator a violation has been observed.
3. The vehicle will be driven in a safe and appropriate manner at all times in accordance with the manufacturers recommendations and applicable laws. It will not be operated on banks, roads berms, newly seeded areas or other locations in a manner that could result in erosion problems.
4. Each operator and/or rider of the registered vehicle will be informed by the undersigned owner of the regulations and responsibilities contained in this document and related POA policies prior to being permitted to operate the vehicle.
5. Guests are permitted to operate the vehicle identified below with the owner's permission. The guest shall operate the vehicle in accordance with these rules, and any such violation of the rules will subject the Property Owner to disciplinary actions as if the owner himself were operating the vehicle at the time of the violation.
6. The roads within the Buck Mountain community were designed for licensed vehicular traffic. The POA assumes no responsibility for operation of off-road vehicles on the roads or within the common areas, deeded trails, or recreational easements.

The undersigned represents that he/she is a member in good standing of the Buck Mountain Property Owners Association, Inc., and has read, understood and agrees that operation of any off-road vehicle is subject to the Off-Road Vehicle Policy established by the Board of Directors and then in effect.

The undersigned agrees to pay the costs of repair for any damage resulting from any off-road vehicle owned, operated or registered by the undersigned, in addition to any fines or penalties that may be administered by the association as the result of a Disciplinary Hearing relating to such incidents, and to indemnify and hold harmless the Buck Mountain Property Owners Association, all members and its Board of Directors from any injury, property damage, or other liability relating to the operation of any off-road vehicle owned, operated or registered by the undersigned.
