



## Welcome to Buck Mountain!

Riding on Buck Mountain roads and trails is a **PRIVILEGE**, not a right.

Your **ATV MUST BE REGISTERED BY A PROPERTY OWNER**, or you may not ride it on the roads or trails.

You must obey **ALL** rules established by the association – some of the important guidelines are highlighted below for your convenience:

- **Quiet Hours** are from **10 PM to 8 AM** each night. Ride only on roads (no trails) and limit your speed to **15 MPH**.
- **Slow down** when approaching pedestrians or other vehicles. Excessive speed is the quickest way to lose the privilege of operating an ATV on Buck Mountain.
- **Stay on marked trails** as many of them are recreational easements through private property. Wandering off the marked trails may subject you to trespassing charges.
- **Ride single file** when riding in a group on our roads, and maintain the vehicle in the right-hand lane at all times. Failure to follow this simple rule can cause serious injury or loss of life.
- **No doughnuts or horse play** is permitted at any time – respect your surroundings and our members. Our roads and trails are not a sporting track, and we expect everyone to ride respectfully.
- **No dirt bikes, two-cycle sport ATVs**, or excessively loud engines – this is a residential community, not a sports training center.

Failure to follow guidelines established by the association is punishable by fines of up to <b>\$100 per day</b>
